## Removing a fixed brace.

When its time to have your fixed brace removed you will come in for a 'de-bond' appointment. This basically means we are going to take your braces off your teeth, polish your teeth up so that they look lovely and shiny.



Step 1: Removing the brace
We start by gently clicking each bracket
so that it just breaks away from the teeth
and the brackets and wire will come out
together in one piece. This procedure only
takes a minute or two at the most.



Step 2: Removing the glue
Once we have taken the braces off, we need to take the glue off the teeth. This is done with a small electric brush with an abrasive attachment. This is quite painless.



**Step 3: Rinsing your mouth**Once the glue has been removed you can give your teeth a quick rinse.



Step 4: Making the retainer
We then take a mould of your teeth,
which our lab technician uses to make a
transparent plastic retainer, which will be
fitted at a second appointment later on
the same day. So it is important to allow
enough time for 2 appointment visits on
the day the brace is being removed.



Step 5: Retainer fitting
At your second appointment your
retainers will be fitted, they may feel a
bit tight at first but it is important to wear
them every night to prevent your teeth
from moving again.



**Step 6: Smile**You are now brace free and ready to show the world your new confident smile.
